

## 2023-2024 Helen P. Denit Financial Awards

The Helen P. Denit Honors Program is pleased to announce the availability of financial awards to support a variety of enriching educational experiences for Helen P. Denit Honors students.

### Eligibility for awards:

- Denit Honors students must:
  - have been enrolled in the Helen P. Denit Honors Program for a minimum of one semester before the activity to be eligible.
  - Be in good academic standing (GPA of 3.3 or higher).
  - Be able to provide supporting documentation (such as receipts or supervisor paperwork) to obtain reimbursement.
  - List a faculty sponsor (a professor, research mentor) to serve as a reference in support of your application.

### Other considerations:

- Priority will be given to students who are actively engaged in the Honors Program (are on track to take the required number of enhanced courses before they graduate and have attended two co-curricular events per semester).
- The Honors Council will take student conduct, completion of required elements of the activity, and adherence to all rules, regulations, and standards of conduct of The University of Baltimore into consideration when making award decisions. Students traveling abroad agree to abide by the laws of the country including but not limited to laws governing the use of alcohol and drugs.

The Honors Council will evaluate applications and make decisions shortly after the application deadlines. However, this monetary support will only be available **after** students participate in the specified activities. Honors students are only eligible to receive **one Denit Financial Award during their studies at The University of Baltimore.**

**At the end of the semester, all student awardees are required to submit a three-page narrative essay** (including pictures if appropriate) summarizing the ways in which the experience shaped their perspective on global issues, culture, and/or their personal and professional goals. This essay should be emailed to Dr. Farley at [sfarley@ubalt.edu](mailto:sfarley@ubalt.edu). Recipients of Research Awards may also be required to present their research in a formal presentation to members of the UBalt and honors communities.

<b><i>Helen P. Denit Honors Program Awards (check which award you are applying for)</i></b>					
<b>Research Initiative for Undergraduates Award</b>  [   ]	This award is designed to financially support faculty-student research collaborations. Students working with a faculty mentor will be awarded up to a <b>\$1000 stipend</b> to complete approximately 80 hours of work on a single intensive research experience during the fall or spring semester. Students completing the work as part of an independent study or other credit-bearing activity are not eligible for this award; the award is designed to encourage research collaborations that are not compensated in other ways. <b>Work can take place in person, virtually, or in a hybrid fashion.</b> Students given this award are expected to present the results of their research to the UBalt and Honors communities.				
<b>Honors Non-paying Internship Support Award</b>  [   ]	This award provides financial support for honors students who complete non-paid, career-related experiences that integrate education with planned and supervised work. Provided the internship requires at least 80 hours, this award entitles students up to a <b>\$1,000 award</b> . To apply for this award, students need to have secured an internship at a certified 501(c)3 organization, registered for a three-credit internship course at the University of Baltimore, and clarified the nature of the expectations of the non-paid internship. To receive the full amount of the award, students must submit a log of worked hours, a letter from the supervisor on organization letterhead certifying that the student completed the required hours, and documentation from the professor of record of the UBalt course that the student has fulfilled the requirements for the course and not received compensation from other sources.				
<b>Global Field Study Award</b>  [ x ]	The Global Field Study Award supports short-term study abroad opportunities that are taken as a part of academic coursework. The award does not support travel that occurs outside of a course. <b>A maximum award of \$1,000 is applied to preapproved study abroad costs (typically the program fee) after travel takes place.</b> In the application essay, students applying for this award should include the name of the course, course dates, the location of the global field study, and the schedule of the study-abroad experience.				
<b>Conference Attendance Award</b>	The Helen P. Denit Honors program encourages honors students' professional skills and career exploration through attending professional conferences. The conference attendance award provides financial support for registration and possible travel expenses for students who wish to attend conferences for their professional				

[ ]	development. Award amounts will vary. Students who present their work at conferences should instead apply for the Turner Grant (see below)
<b>Partners in the Parks Award</b> [ ]	The University of Baltimore is a member of the National Collegiate Honors Conference, which supports a wonderful experiential learning program called <a href="#">Partners in the Parks</a> . This program supports short-term summer travel experiences to National Parks. The award supports up to \$1000 of reimbursement for program fees.
<b>Conference Presentation Award</b> *Not Honors Sponsored	The <a href="#">Turner Research and Travel Award</a> is processed through the Research Council. Students who <i>present</i> their research at local, regional, and national conferences may apply for reimbursement of their travel expenses through this grant, which prioritizes applications from honors students. Please note that the Turner deadlines are different from the deadlines mentioned above. Follow the link for more information.
