

# Certificate in Business in Fundamentals

The graduate certificate in Business Fundamentals emphasizes student choice in fulfilling career needs. This certificate is designed primarily for participants interested in learning some of the basic concepts of business or who are considering the eventual completion of an MBA, but desire a sampling of courses. Local, national and international organizations frequently consider the Business Fundamentals as an option for maintaining the currency of their human capital.

- **Certificate Requirements**

To receive a Certificate in Accounting Fundamentals, you must complete eight of the following courses and maintain a cumulative GPA of no less than 3.0 for courses taken in the certificate program. The coursework must be completed after you have received a bachelor's degree or equivalent.

**Required courses (12 credits):**

- ACCT 505 | Introduction to Accounting (1.5 cr)
- ECON 505 | Microeconomics (1.5 cr)
- ECON 506 | Macroeconomics (1.5 cr)
- FIN 505 | Financial Management (1.5 cr) (prerequisites: ACCT 505 and ECON 505)
- MKTG 505 | Marketing Essentials (1.5 cr)
- OPM 505 | Introduction to Operations Management (1.5 cr)
- OPRE 505 | Fundamentals of Statistics (1.5)
- OPRE 506 | Managerial Statistics (1.5) (prerequisite: OPRE 505)
