

FAQ relative to Summer 2020 mandatory fee calculations May 14, 2020

1) Why was the student center fee not adjusted with no one will being able to use the student center for summer semester?

The student center fee covers the bond debt, renewal and replacement, and utilities for the building. These are fixed institutional costs. The students and the University committed to these payments when the funds were borrowed to construct the building.

2) I want to inquire about a refund for additional printing on-campus.

Refunds for these charges were processed on May 08, 2020

3) Why do summer fees seem so high considering they are going to be web classes?

Summer 2020 mandatory fees are:

Auxiliary Construction Fee is \$3 per credit (from 1-11 credits). The full-time rate of \$36 applies to 12 or more credits. Auxiliary Operating Fee is \$7.34 per credit (from 1-11 credits). The full-time rate of \$88.08 applies to 12 or more credits. Student Center Fee is \$34 per credit (from 1-11 credits). The full-time rate of \$407 applies to 12 or more credits. Student Services Fee is \$21 per credit (from 1-11 credits). The full-time rate of \$252 applies to 12 or more credits. Technology Fee is \$9 per credit (from 1-11 credits). The full-time rate of \$108 applies to 12 or more credits. Student Government Association Fee is a flat rate of \$25 or Student Bar Association fee is a flat rate of \$37.

The auxiliary operating fee per credit hour rate is reduced by 68%, from \$23 to \$7.34. The entire SBA fee will be reduced for School of Law students. The technology and student center fees support ongoing fixed costs, specifically, debt service and renewal and replacement. The student service units are providing 100% of their services remotely and the SGA will provide their normal summer semester activities.

4) Will the university be removing the auxiliary fees and student services fees because we will not be utilizing any of the services due to the current COVID-19 crisis?

The auxiliary operating fee per credit hour rate is reduced by 68%, from \$23 to \$7.34. The entire SBA fee will be reduced for School of Law students. The technology and student center fees support ongoing fixed costs, specifically debt service and renewal and replacement. The student service units are providing 100% of their services remotely and the SGA will provide their normal summer semester activities.
